Competition Structure

Weekend competition games will start at approx. 8:15am and finish at approx. 8pm, with youngest age groups first.

Wednesday's competition games will start from approx. 7pm and finish at approx. 10pm.

Every competition runs in line with the Victorian public school terms, and there are no rounds on Victorian Public Holidays or long weekends including Queen's Birthday, Melbourne Cup, Easter, Labour Day. For the full domestic Winter season calendar, go to <u>www.mckinnonbasketball.org/domestic</u>

The Winter 2024 season will run from Term 2 to the end of Term 3.

Grading

The first four rounds of the competition will be grading games. Clubs will be asked to enter teams into divisions which will be reviewed by MBA. Results will be reviewed weekly by MBA. Teams may need to be moved to a different division based on factors such as results and feedback from clubs/teams.

The MBA will hold a grading meeting in the middle of the grading period and at the end of Round 4 to finalise teams into divisions. MBA make the final grading decisions.

U8 Competition

- Player must have turned 5 years of age by start of season
- Modified rules:
 - 4 x 4 competition
 - 2 x 15-minute halves
 - 1 x 3 minute half time break -all players from both teams shoot a free throw for an opportunity to add to team score (if individual score limit has not been reached)
- No grading and no separate divisions (separate groups may apply depending on team numbers)
- 15 x regular rounds *plus....*
- Round Robin format (round 16)

Registration

All players must be registered prior to taking the court in any McKinnon Basketball Association domestic competition game.

Independent Team Registration Fee 16 x regular rounds (weekend competition) 19 x regular rounds (Wednesday competition)

Independent Team Entry (U8-18)	\$1420 per team
U20/Senior/Open Team Entry	\$1280 per team
Wednesday Senior Team Entry	\$1520 per team

The MBA team registration fee includes:

- Competition Court Hire
- Competition Administration
- Competition Operations
- Game Day Equipment
- Provision of Game Day Referees, Supervisors and Staff

Note: Above fees do not include makeup rounds/finals team sheet fees. These fees will be charged per team on game day.

Semi Final team sheet \$80 per team

Grand Final team sheet \$85 per team (includes referee adjudicator on score bench)

Independent Player Registration Costs

All independent players must register with their team before taking the court. Your team organiser will share a participation link with you.

Season Stadium Door Entry Fees

Each player will pay the season door pass at the time of registration. This will cover spectators and players for the regular season.

\$96 Junior (U8-20) Weekend competition

\$48 Senior/Open Weekend competition

\$57 Wednesday Evening competition

*Players and spectators will be charged a door entry fee to all Finals games.

Basketball Victoria Participation Licence Fee

Basketball Victoria charges a Participation Licence fee to help cover the costs of managing the sport, which includes providing services and insurance to participants, clubs and associations.

Cost

*\$29.00 per player for Juniors (17 and under) annually / 365 days *\$43.00 per player for Seniors (18 and over) annually / 365 days

This fee will be charged at time of player registration for new players or if due for renewal.

Basketball Australia Participant Fee (Game Development Levy)

From January 1st 2024, an annual Basketball Australia Game Development levy of:

\$5.00 (+GST) per competition player will be introduced nationwide.

The levy will be collected by Basketball Australia and the additional revenue generated will play a pivotal role in sustaining the growth of basketball for generations to come. The fee is to be paid upon player registration through PlayHQ.

Finals Eligibility

To be eligible to play finals a player must have taken the court and played at least 7 of scheduled games within that team within the season.

Domestic Clearance Form

MBA has moved to electronic transfers using PlayHQ. Participants will be prompted to lodge a clearance when they go to register with their new club. Clubs and Independent teams will only be allowed to accept two (2) clearances coming from each age group and division from a single club each season. Refer to MBA bylaws.

Referee Supervisor

At McKinnon Basketball Association, we employ Referee Supervisor's who assist the referees in their development and ensure game are played in the spirit of the competition. Referee Supervisor's can often be seen at venues throughout our competitions encouraging and supporting referees.

Referees

MBA referees are often players, teenagers, adults, coaches, life members of the sport who are giving back and are a crucial part in ensuring the competition runs each week.

It is important we all play our part in helping our referees develop by allowing them to referee the game. If you have queries on game days, a coach or player may politely speak to a referee. Spectators are not to approach referee's and must adhere to the Spectator Code of Conduct.

Scoring

Every team must provide at least one competent scorer for each game which is often organised by a team manager. There are two roles on the score bench:

1. The game clock

This is the visual for players, spectators and coaches to see the score.

2. The iPad

This is the official tracking, and where results are submitted from at the end of each day. It important the iPad is correct upon completion of the game.

Pathways

The McKinnon Cougars field both male and female teams from U12 -

The McKinnon Cougars field both male and female teams from U12 – U20 that play in the Victorian Junior Basketball League (VJBL). Cougar teams are made up of players within our association who play at one of our nine domestic clubs and want to take their basketball more seriously.

The McKinnon Cougars also have 4 Senior representative teams entered in Basketball Victoria's Big V semi-professional League.

The representative program is aimed at players and coaches who are committed to developing their basketball skills and knowledge of the game.

McKinnon Basketball goes through an extensive try-out period, whereby if players are successful, they will be selected in a team for the following VJBL season.

The pathway for athletes to participate and play in Basketball Victoria's State programs, State teams, College, Big V, NBL1, NBL and WNBL usually begins with a Representative program such as McKinnon Cougars.
